DATA PRIVACY STATEMENT HackGuard Personal Cyber Insurance

We, at Anchor Insurance Brokerage Corporation and its subsidiaries ("AIBC"), respect your privacy and are committed to protecting and keeping secure all personal and sensitive information that you may provide to AIBC, and/or those that we may collect from you ("Personal Data").

This Privacy Statement ("Statement") describes the Personal Data we collect in relation to the HackGuard Personal Cyber Insurance, and the standards we observe in collecting, using, processing, storing, securing, retaining, and disclosing such Personal Data, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

By providing your Personal Data, you expressly acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to the terms of this Statement, and you consent for us to:

- ✓ Process your Personal Data for purposes of enrollment, evaluation, and issuance of your HackGuard Personal Cyber Insurance policy;
- ✓ Share your Personal Data with our insurance provider, Cocogen Insurance, and authorized third-party service providers, affiliates, subsidiaries, contractors, and other entities necessary for the administration of your insurance coverage; and
- ✓ Retain and process your Personal Data in accordance with our policies and applicable laws and regulations.

Personal Data We Collect and Process

In relation to HackGuard Personal Cyber Insurance, we collect and process the following Personal Data of employees and their dependents:

- ✓ Full Name
- ✓ Mailing Address
- ✓ Contact Number
- ✓ Email Address
- ✓ Employee Number

We collect your Personal Data through enrollment forms, application forms, employer submissions, and other related communications.

Any additional Personal Data that you may voluntarily provide in connection with your insurance application shall likewise be treated as Personal Data.

Failure to provide accurate and complete Personal Data may result in delay or inability to process your insurance enrollment or policy issuance.

Purpose of Processing Personal Data

Your Personal Data is collected and processed for the following purposes:

- ✓ Evaluation and processing of your enrollment and application;
- ✓ Policy issuance and administration of your HackGuard Personal Cyber Insurance;
- ✓ Validation of your eligibility and insurance coverage; and

- ✓ Compliance with legal, regulatory, and contractual obligations.

Disclosure and Sharing of Personal Data

Your Personal Data may be shared, disclosed, or made accessible to:

- ✓ Cocogen Insurance, as the insurance provider, for underwriting and policy issuance;
- ✓ Authorized third-party service providers supporting insurance administration; and
- ✓ Government agencies and regulators, when required by law.

All recipients are required to maintain the confidentiality and security of your Personal Data.

Retention of Personal Data

Your Personal Data shall be retained for five (5) years from the last renewal or subscription of your insurance policy, or longer if required by law, regulation, or legitimate business purposes.

After the applicable retention period, your Personal Data shall be securely disposed of in accordance with AIBC's data retention and disposal policies and applicable regulations.

Your Rights as a Data Subject

You have the following rights under applicable data privacy laws:

- Right to be informed of the processing of your Personal Data;
- Right to access your Personal Data;
- Right to correct inaccurate or incomplete Personal Data;
- Right to object to processing;
- Right to request erasure or blocking, subject to legal limitations; and
- Right to lodge a complaint with the National Privacy Commission in case of violation of your rights.

Security of Your Personal Data

AIBC has implemented appropriate technical, organizational, and physical security measures designed to protect your Personal Data against unauthorized access, disclosure, misuse, alteration, loss, or destruction.

These measures include access controls, secure storage, confidentiality obligations, and data protection policies.
